THE ASSOCIATION OF CONNECTICUT FAIRS, INC. SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Association of Connecticut Fairs annual scholarships are available to all students active in member fairs without discrimination as to race, color or creed. Applicants must be sponsored by a member fair of the Association of Connecticut Fairs, Inc. and be enrolled at an accredited institution of higher learning.

THREE \$1000.00 scholarships will be awarded annually to a graduating high school senior or a current college student.

- One scholarship will be awarded to a student pursuing a course of study in agriculture, family consumer science or a related field during the next academic year.
- One scholarship will be awarded to a student pursuing a course of study in any field during the next academic year.
- One scholarship will be awarded to a student to be chosen at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee

The following factors will be considered by the selection committee:

Fair Participation: 30% Scholastic Standing: 25% Financial Need: 25% Citizenship and Leadership: 20%
